Childhaven

Childhaven provides therapeutic day care to children who are in danger of, or have experienced, abuse and neglect. By teaching parents how to better bond with their children and by helping children overcome their trauma, Childhaven offers many families a second chance to stay together.

Jumping Mouse Children's Center

At Jumping Mouse, trained therapists use expressive mental health therapy - such as drawing, sand play, movement and puppets - to help young children heal from the trauma of domestic violence or abuse. This Port Townsend agency is sought after as a replicable model in other parts of Washington.

YouthCare

The first shelter for homeless youth in the Western U.S., YouthCare helps youth exit street life by offering services such as street outreach, shelter, education and employment training. Beginning in 1974 as a three-bed shelter for runaways, YouthCare has grown to six sites serving the greater Seattle area.
